**Homestay:**

All students will live in New Zealand English speaking families with children. Meals will be provided by the families. Students will be driven to and from school, or take bus with Helensville schoolmates or teachers. All families have been vetted by the school staff and the police.

**Lessons:**

Each student will be assigned a school buddy. During school days, they will have lessons in their buddies' class. Some special classes will also be arranged for the Hong Kong students.

**Tour:**City tour

The City tour is to let students have an idea about the Auckland City. They will visit Mt Eden where students have a 360 degree view of the Auckland City. It is also formed from the crater of a volcano. Students can see the shape of the crater. Another spot is the Joseph Savage Memorial Park, a quiet and beautiful park where they can see the outlying islands. On the way, the bus will go past different places in central city, such as Queen's Street, Sky Tower and the University.

Auckland War Memorial Museum

In this 3 hours visit, students will learn about the Maori culture, natural life, natural disasters and the history of New Zealand.

Muriwai Beach

On Wednesday afternoon, students will visit the Muriwai Beach with a spectacular view of the Tasman Sea and the black sand beach. The most interesting part is the gannet colony where gannets can be watched at a close distance.

Auckland Zoo

In the Auckland Zoo, students can see different kinds of animals from all over the world. The highlight is watching the kiwi bird which is the icon of New Zealand. We may also be able to feed the giraffes.

Sheep World

Students can enjoy a step by step insight into how farmers in New Zealand farm their sheep, then harvest and use their wool. As well as demonstrating the NZ sheep and wool story, Sheep World has some great ways to experience NZ nature first hand and to meet with some of the friendly wildlife and farm animals.

**Cost:** The cost per student includes the following:

- Economy class return direct flight between Hong Kong and Auckland
- travel insurance
- 6 school days of lessons/activities at host School;
- 8 nights of homestay in pairs at a NZ family (3 daily meals included);
- all admission and transport cost of the trips mentioned in the programme;
- 2 nights' accommodation and meals at a Holiday Park/ motel;
- transport to and from the Auckland airport;
- tax and airport fee
